Subject: **ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES: SPRUCE GROVE RURAL NORTH BOUNDARY CHANGE – WOODHAVEN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND GREYSTONE CENTENNIAL MIDDLE SCHOOL**

Recommendation

That the Board of Trustees approve the Spruce Grove Rural North boundary change from Woodhaven Middle School to Greystone Centennial Middle School for the 2011-2012 school year as presented at the Regular Meeting of 05 April 2011.

Background

The System Review Planning Principles identified “enable co-terminus arrangements” as a criterion to create and evaluate options whenever possible. Co-terminus boundaries direct groups of students based on their attendance at a particular school to transition to another school as an entire group of students. The above recommendation supports all Grade 4 students at Parkland Village School to attend Greystone Centennial Middle School in Grade 5. Public feedback from both Phase One and Phase Two of the System Review, Public Information Open Houses supported this recommendation.
