Recommendation

That the Board of Trustees approve the Spruce Grove (Rural South) boundary change from Brookwood School and Greystone Centennial Middle School to Graminia School for the 2011-2012 school year as presented at the Regular Meeting of 05 April 2011.

Background

Public feedback from phase one of the System Review public open houses strongly supported rural students attending rural schools where urban schools are overcrowded. Feedback from phase two of the System Review public open houses supported Parkland School Division's proposal for a rural boundary change from Brookwood School and Greystone Centennial Middle School (Rural South) to Graminia School for "new" Rural South students.
